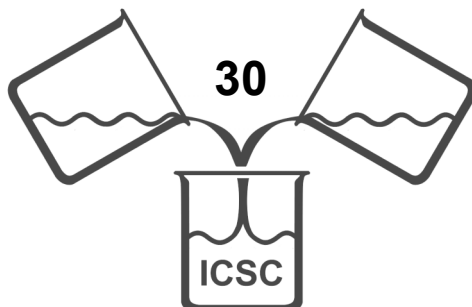


30th International Conference on Solution Chemistry

Location

Perth, located on the pristine Swan River, is the capital city of the State of Western Australia. With a population of over one million, Perth has all the

facilities expected of a thriving modern city, including art galleries, museums, parks, and shopping.

Perth is well served by direct international air flights (over 150 flights per week on 10 major international airlines) and has excellent connections to the eastern seaboard of Australia, with over 50 flights per day.

July is mid-winter in Perth but the weather is mild with an average daily maximum temperature of 18 °C (64 °F) dropping to 8 °C (44 °F) overnight. Rainfall is significant at this time of the year but there are typically many sunny days with an average of 6 h of sunlight per day.

Perth is within easy reach of many natural attractions such as the Pinnacles desert, National Parks, Rottnest Island, Aboriginal sites, Western Australia's unique wildflowers and the Margaret River wine region.

Participants will stay in the historic port area of Fremantle, which has a wide range of accommodation options, numerous shops, cafes and restaurants and a vibrant nightlife.

All Conference sessions will be held at Murdoch University, which is an easy bus-ride from Fremantle.
